no photo yet	<p>← Aerangis (somalensis x mystacidii) This is a compact/miniature plant, which sets a spray of white, star shaped flowers. BS plants, mounted. \$25</p> <p>→ Aerides lawrencea x Vanda Sasicha There is something special about Aer lawrencea hybrids. Upright spike with pink/purple medium sized flowers. BS & in bud, in baskets \$52</p>	no photo yet
no photo yet	<p>← Amesiella Sparkling Jewel (philippinensis x monticola) = round white flowers on small plants. These plants are NBS/BS in 2" pots. Grow in basket or mounted. \$38</p> <p>→ Ascocentrum Mona Church (miniatum x ampullaceum), very compact plants, when mature, can set impressive spikes. Orange flowers, in 3" net pot. \$20</p>	
	<p>← Christocentrum Penang Sunset (Christensonia vietnamica x Ascocentrum ampullaceum), small plant, blooms at random times, orange flowers. Mounted \$30</p> <p>→ Aeridofinetia Hiroshima Choice (Aerides flabellata x Neofinetia falcata), which have both been reclassified as Vandas. Light pink flowers on small plants. NBS in net pot \$30</p>	
	<p>← Ascocofinetia Cherry Blossom 'Carmela' (Neofinetia falcata x Ascocentrum ampullaceum), this is an easy grower and bloomer, pink flowers in May/June. BS plant in 3.1/2" pot \$30</p> <p>→ Ascocofinetia Fuch's Ocean Spray (Neost Lou Sneary x Rhy coelestis), this is a cool/intermediate grower. BS plant in 3.1/2" net pot. \$30</p>	
no photo yet	<p>← Neofinetia falcata x Renanthera citrina Recently deflasked seedlings (Marni Turkel breeding), will take 3-4 years to reach BS. \$15</p> <p>→ Renanetia Sunrise (Neofinetia falcata x Renanthera imschootiana) produces warm orange/red flowers on branching spikes from mature plants. NBS: \$25 BS: \$38</p>	
	<p>← Rhynchostylis gigantea x Vanda Suksamran Spots Rhy gigantea hybrids tend to be a bit more managable in size, and they produce spectacular flowers. BS in basket \$48</p> <p>→ Rhynchorides Thai Noi (Rhy coelestis x Aer flabellata). This is the sort of 'weird' breeding, which frequently yields stunning results. BS in basket \$50</p>	
	<p>← Vanda Miss Joaquim, 'Douglas' AM/AOS This is a terete leaf hybrid. For a challenge (it needs a lot of light), in a 4" net pot, about 1 year from BS \$15</p> <p>→ Vanda (Asca Christine Ang x denisoniana) x sib This cross is producing both white and yellow flowers. BS seedlings in 5" pot. \$40</p>	
	<p>← Vascostylis Pine Rivers 'Pink' (ASCDA Peggy Foo x Rhy coelestis), one of the most successful Vascostylis hybrids. Can bloom 3-4 times a year. BS plant in net pot \$45</p> <p>→</p>
